



Update to Five Rivers Council Unit COVID-19 Policy

Revised June 15, 2021

With the approval of your Chartered Organization as well as following all CDC, State, and Local recommendations units can conduct meetings, activities, and camping events under the following requirements:

Council Wide Requirements:

The Boy Scouts of America has issued the following requirements for all Scouting activities.

- Individuals must isolate if they are sick, and not attend any activity/meeting/event if they, anyone they live with, or anyone they have recently been around feels unwell.
- Individuals must not attend any activity/meeting/event if they or anyone they live with has tested positive for COVID-19 in the past 10 days or have another illness and do not have the results of a COVID-19 back.
- Individuals who are not fully vaccinated, must wear a face covering or mask that covers your nose and mouth and stay at least 6 feet apart from people they don't live with.
- Attendees should wash their hands often with soap and water. Use hand sanitizer if soap and water are not available.
- Until further notice, international travel is not considered an official Scouting Activity.

Unit Meetings, Events, and Overnight Camping:

- Unvaccinated individuals continue to be responsible for wearing masks, in accordance with federal CDC *guidance*.
- Units are required to follow the regulations of the state and local area in which they are conducting a meeting, event, or camping event regardless of the regulations of their area of residency.
- Follow all guidelines of the meeting place, park, or campground.
